Bag all your own trash during the campfire and throughout the night to help keep our parks clean. There is an optional Pack 850 Family Camp-In at the Park overnight until ~9am October 18, 2009.**

***If you plan to camp, arrive early -- by 4:30pm to allow sufficient time to set up before dusk. Cub Scouts can overnight only with their respective parents. Scout families are responsible to provide all their overnight needs including their own tents, sleeping bags, air mattresses, lanterns, flashlights, food, water, and toiletries. Public toilets are available next to Parking Lot F.**

Attending families please dress warmly and bring: flashlights or lanterns, blankets or tarps, and folding chairs or "sit-upons" for your viewing enjoyment of the Campfire festivities. There is public lighting of parking facilities only.

Following the Campfire, we will serve hot cocoa and donut holes. Bring a travel mug for your hot chocolate.

Please contact your Den Leaders with questions. If you plan to camp overnight, please let your Den Leader know.

Directions: Take River Road to Amwell Road heading East towards Franklin Township. At traffic light intersection of Mettlars Lane, turn left. Follow Mettlars until you reach the second left entrance into Colonial Park, take it & follow to Parking Lot F. Walk over embankment towards tree line to Campfire Pit - the center of our stage for the evening. See you there!
